



Reach certificate

REACH is the European Chemical regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 which entered into force in June 2007. The regulation covers registration, evaluation, authorization and restriction processes for chemicals substances to ensure the consistency of regulations across EU. These REACH processes are designed to provide additional information on chemicals, to ensure their safe use and to ensure competitiveness of the European industry.

The papers produced by Arjowiggins Graphic and supplied to our customers are considered as 'Articles' within the REACH regulations and therefore are not required to be registered. However, as a user of chemical substances, Arjowiggins Graphic takes all necessary steps to ensure that the impact of REACH on our own raw material purchases will not influence the range of products, the quality or the current standards of chemical safety of our paper.

In accordance to REACH Article 33 (1) which requires manufacturers and distributors of Articles to inform their customers if an Article contains more than 0,1% (1000 ppm) weight by weight (w/w) of any Candidate List Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC), Arjowiggins Graphic certifies that all Graphic Printing & Writing papers do not contain any Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) as detailed within the current list of Restricted substances.

This certificate is established to be worth that of right.
